Work with supervisors and Program Coordinators in planning and developing new programs, special events and implementing new programs. Complete individual activity assessments, discharge summaries and group notes according to hospital policy. Demonstrate the ability to write and update individualized treatment plans that provide active treatment to assigned patients in accordance with CMS regulations

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Ability to keep accurate records and write reports. Ability to interact with patients and other professionals in a courteous, professional manner. Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing. Knowledge of individual and group behavior and effective ways of working with mentally ill patients. Ability to utilize professional data in planning and evaluating the activities programs and to adapt and implement such programs as required.
