MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Standard High School graduation, and graduation from a state-approved School of Practical Nurse Education.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a certificate of registration as a Practical Nurse issued by the Alabama Board of Nursing.

KIND OF WORK: This position is the Patient Education Program Instructor for seriously mentally ill adult and geriatric patients. Work includes the following duties and responsibilities: Conducts classes to educate patients about their hospitalization, psychiatric disorder, services and interventions, recovery, and release to the community; Confers with Treatment Team and other staff related to patients' attendance and progress; Completes accurate and timely progress notes; Attends Treatment Team meetings as needed; Attends in-services and meetings; Structures educational outings for patients; Assists in coordinating trips with patients; and Assists with duties necessary to maintain clean classrooms, kitchen and laundry room, adequate supplies, and update Universal Precaution trays.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES: Ability to read and comprehend documents; Knowledge of prescribed medication types; Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing. Knowledge of first-aid techniques; Knowledge of isolation and restraint techniques; Ability to organize job tasks; Ability to use various software programs; Ability to

interact with various types of people; Ability to make independent decisions; and Ability to establish priorities.

METHOD OF SELECTION: Applicants will be rated on the basis of an evaluation of their job related training, abilities, experience, and education, and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as above mentioned. All relevant information is subject to verification. **Drug screening and security clearances will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment whose job requires direct contact with patients.**
