The office is located at 1110 Montlimar Drive in suite 500. In addition to basic services, the practice will also offer enhanced services such as neuropsychology, memory assessment, comprehensive ADHD evaluations, TMS treatment for depression, hypnosis, biofeedback and neurofeedback.
