The Birmingham Barons are back in town at Regions Field for a 5-game homestand against the Biloxi Shuckers from April 26-30 which includes such special promotional events as Mardi Gras Night Crawfish Boil, Autism Friendly Day and Talladega Tribute.

The homestand also includes such regular events as Thirsty Thursday and Friday Night Fireworks.

The Barons (9-11) come home after dropping a 9-7 game against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos on the road in Florida after starting the game with a 4-0 lead. Despite the loss, the series against Pensacola was one highlighted by offensive production by the Barons.

The team finished the five-game series with 11 home runs after hitting just six over the first 15 games of the season.
