

Police confirm Bridgette Marshall's death was suicide

Bridgette Marshall, wife of Alabama Attorney General Steve Marshall, died as the result of a self-inflicted gunshot wound, according to a report from Murfreesboro, Tennessee police.

Murfreesboro officers were called to an apartment on Puckett Creek Crossing about 7:46 a.m. Sunday by a female relative of Bridgette Marshall's who said Marshall was making suicidal statements. The report
