City receives park grant

The City of Atmore has received a grant from Escambia County Children's Policy Council (CPC) to renovate Westside Park adjacent to Nashville Avenue.

The grant originated as a part of the State Preventative Framework grant awarded by the Alabama Department of Mental Health to the CPC. The purpose of the grant is to develop strategies and implement techniques to deter underage drinking.

District 5 City Councilman Chris Harrison said, "The monies from this grant will be used to renovate the Westside Park. This will include the addition of lighting, shrubbery and some benches. The grounds will be renovated and a parking lot added. The city had recently resurfaced the basketball court and with this grant we will be able to continue to improve the area for the community."

Judge David Jordan and Judge Jeff White are the chairmen of the CPC who authorized the funding for the project. Karean Reynolds administers the day-to-day operations of the CPC.
