Nonprofit offering outreach seeking treatment for addicts

An organization that offers peer-based support services to individuals seeking addiction treatment is trying to establish a foothold in Walker County.

Several representatives of the Recovery Organization of Support Specialists will be in Jasper on Saturday to hand out literature and help connect individuals with recovery resources.

"We're the liason between the addict and the clinical side. There is a gap there that needs to be bridged because the addict is scared if they've never tried to get sober before and they usually don't have the resources," said Denae Davis, a peer support specialist with ROSS.

Peer support specialists are individuals who are living in recovery themselves and have received training to help others navigate the various systems of care available to those seeking treatment.

Peer support specialists have at least two years of sobriety. "We are using our own experience to help other people," Davis said.

The group from ROSS will be set up in front of Son's from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday.

Beginning next week, peer support specialists from ROSS will be in Walker County on a daily basis.

ROSS, a nonprofit based in Homewood, offers a range of services before and after treatment that are available to individuals seeking recovery as well as family members.

The services include screening/intake, relapse prevention planning, crisis support and peer-led support groups.
