Gadsden, Ala.—Gadsden State’s Continuing Education Department and Division of Health Sciences is partnering with Gadsden Regional Medical Center and Alabama Area Health Education Centers to sponsor a Mental Health Conference from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Oct. 12 at Helderman Hall Auditorium on the Wallace Drive Campus.
