Q&A

- 1) Will all services in the ADMH contract billing manual that apply to OP, be an allowable code billed? Would there be a possible Targeted Case Management Component? **Yes, all services in billing manual that apply to OP will be allowable, special women services have an enhanced billing rate. Case management is required for all special women programs.**
- 2) Regarding services that are to be rendered for children – In what capacity would HCA be responsible for these services? Would we be responsible for payment of daycare etc, if we set up these services? **The agency providing special women services is responsible for children’s services. The agency can have either an onsite daycare or have a MOU with a local childcare provider to offer the daycare services. Other children services such as counseling can be done by the agency or by an outside agency via a MOU. Community partnerships is a MUST for special women’s programs.**
- 3) Would a separate chart be opened up for the child and billed separately? **Yes, there must be a separate chart for the child that indicates services performed by the agency and services/referrals done outside of the agency.**
- 4) Do you have recent data on how many Special Women’s admissions into OP there has been in recent years? **Not able to pull that data at this time.**
- 5) We currently have 5 certified sites. Would we have to submit a proposal for each site, or would it be one proposal for all? **You will need to submit a proposal for the location(s) you would want to place the special women’s services.**
