



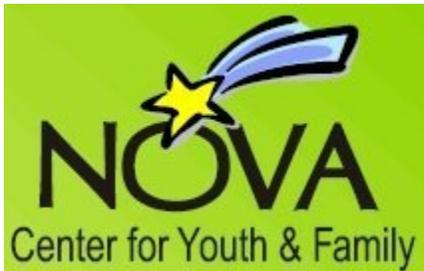
Nova Center for Youth and Family to celebrate National Prevention Week
