





**Board Name:** Vivian B. Adams School Board

<u>County(ies) Served:</u> Dale, Coffee, Barbour, Henry, Houston and Pike

<u>Description of Services/Supports Provided:</u> Vivian B. Adams School provides Day Habilitation Services, Case Management Services, Personal Care Services for Adult Individuals in the counties served. In addition, Vivian B. Adams School has an Early Intervention Program that provides Service Coordination, Special Instruction and Therapy Services to children ages 0-3.

<u>Population(s) Served:</u> Description – Vivian B. Adams School serves primarily the developmentally delayed or Intellectually Disabled who may have other disabilities to include but not limited to; cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, epilepsy, spina bifida, down syndrome, hydrocephalus, aphasia, autism, sensory impairment and sclerosis.

<u>Demographics</u>: Vivian B. Adams School currently serves 119 adult Individuals and 18 infants age 0-3. The breakdown of the adult population is: White Male -49, Black Male -22, White Female -30, Black Female -17, Hispanic Female -1.

<u>Mission Statement:</u> To support persons with Intellectual Disabilities to develop and to select a personally successful and independent life as possible.


<u>Vision Statement:</u> Policy: It is the policy of the <u>Vivian B. Adams School Board</u> (VBASB) to promote the vision of the Board through its mission, goal and objectives and to review its vision annually.

<u>Mission:</u> To support persons with Intellectual Disabilities to develop and to select a personally successful and independent life as possible.

<u>Philosophy:</u> The VBASB endeavors to foster the philosophy that persons with Intellectual disabilities have the right to participate in their community as equal citizens.

**Scope:** All services/supports offered by VBASB are available to any citizen of Dale County who has a developmental disability. As capacity allows, school, adult habilitation services and case management services are available to citizens in surrounding counties who have been referred by their county 310 board

<u>Context of Services/Supports:</u> The vision context is an environment of enrichment and safety in which students/Individuals may learn needed skills without fear of abuse, neglect or



mistreatment. Students/Individuals receive the services/supports in an environment which is free from discrimination by race, sex, age, ethnicity, disability, religion, sexual orientation or financial circumstances. This context is a prime and non-negotiable component of the system.

<u>Description of Planning Cycle:</u> Vivian B. Adams School implements a three year planning cycle that begins January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year and runs through December 31<sup>st</sup> of the third year. The plan will be evaluated and updated annually.

<u>Planning Cycle Timeframe:</u> The 2010-2012 plan was approved at the December 2009 meeting of the Vivian B. Adams School Board. The VBASB will evaluate and adjust the plan annually at its November/December board meeting.

**<u>Key Stakeholders and roles:</u>** Individuals, Parents, Caregivers, Vivian B. Adams School Administrators, Staff, VBASB and Local agencies.

Roles: Individuals - Participate in ISP meetings, Individual Surveys, Individuals' Advisory Council

<u>Parents</u> – Participate in ISP meeting, Parent surveys, Parent Advisory Council Meetings and QUEST meetings.

<u>Administrators</u> – Administrative Council Planning Sessions, Regional Planning Sessions and Board of Directors Planning Session.

<u>Local Agencies</u> – Will serve on QUEST committee to assist in making planning recommendations.

Methods of Needs Assessment: Individual needs are assessed using a functional assessment and ICAP summary on an annual basis. Overall needs are assessed using a Parent/Individual Survey and a Staff Survey distributed annually. A Consumer Advisory Committee meets monthly and a Parent Advisory committee quarterly to discuss individual's needs and make suggestions to improve individual programs. In addition to the above, the QUEST (CQI) committee meets monthly to assess immediate needs and or trends both positive and negative.

Contracts with Local Education Agencies, approximately 10%. Grants, approximately 5%. Individual gifts, approximately 5%. Local Government approximately 5%.

**Future Funding Sources:** All sources listed above. In addition, Vivian B. Adams would like to establish an endowment of \$1,million of which the interest could be used to further the goals of the school. Federal Grants should be explored to determine their feasibility. Federal Transportation Grant monies should be extended over the 2010-2012 years.
