The FATAL FIVE

The Fatal Five are five commonly identified causes of preventable death in persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities and in persons who are aging.

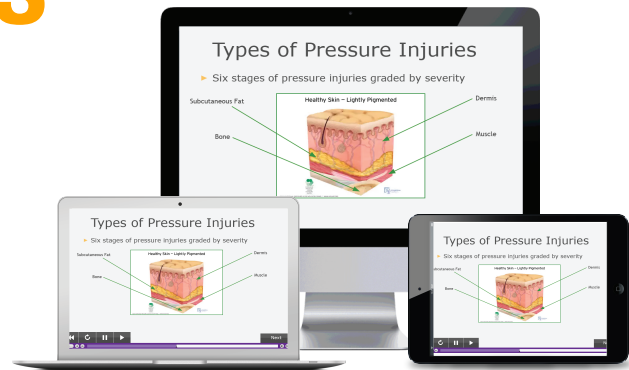
The Fatal Five encompasses those conditions that, when recognized early and treated promptly, can save lives and prevent negative changes in the person's health.

These five conditions are:

- ▶ Aspiration
- ▶ Bowel Obstruction
- ▶ GERD
- ▶ Seizures
- ▶ Infection/Sepsis

Plus two additional, important topics:

- ▶ Dehydration
- ▶ Knowing When to Act



The Fatal Five series has a choice of three courses with their own focus depending on whether you are a DSP, a clinician or a Case Manager/QDDP*. Each module includes easy-to-understand content with illustrations, knowledge checks and scenarios to enhance understanding.

Taking these courses will give you the ability to recognize early signs and symptoms of these conditions and feel empowered to do something about it!
