

The goal of the School-Based Mental Health Services (SBMH) collaboration between Alabama Department of Mental Health and its providers and the Alabama Department of Education and Alabama's local education agencies is to ensure that children and adolescents, both general and special education, enrolled in local school systems have access to high quality mental health prevention, early intervention, and treatment services. The aim is to achieve greater integration of mental health services between the community mental health centers and the public schools and to increase the utilization of evidence-based practices. Funding for the SBMH projects vary by location and can include local funds (school contracts, local grants, etc.), state funds, and grant funds.
