

Emergency Recovery Housing

Emergency recovery housing defined: Individuals who are waiting on a residential treatment placement will be temporarily housed in a recovery home bed until their residential treatment placement is available to avoid addiction setbacks. This emergency housing initiative is intended to address the barrier of individuals not having a living environment conducive to recovery. The recovery homes listed below participate in emergency recovery housing. Each follows the protocol listed in the Emergency Housing Plan (available upon request).
