RE: COVID-19 Mandates Expirations

Please note the following Alabama COVID-19 Pandemic End Dates:

- o Governor Kay Ivey's Safer at Home Order: ended April 9, 2021
- o City of Montgomery's Extended Mask Mandate: ended May 9, 2021
- o Alabama COVID-19 Public Health Order: May 31, 2021
- o Alabama COVID-19 State of Emergency: July 6, 2021
- o Employees working in other areas are to abide by mandates in effect for their area.

The health and safety of ADMH Employees continues to be a primary focus as we move forward with future COVID-19 protocols, therefore the current COVID-19 Guidelines remain active for ADMH Central Office and Regional Office Staff:

1. Masks, along with other mitigation strategies, are strongly encouraged as we should continue efforts to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace. www.maskssaveslives.org
2. Employee Screening Forms are no longer required. However, employees should continue to check their temperature before arriving to work.
3. Supervisor Reporting Sheets along with the tracking of COVID-19 cases should continue. Supervisor Reporting Sheets are important for the purposes of contact tracing, reduction in the spreading of COVID-19 and data collection for future funding opportunities.
4. Meetings should be conducted in person with a virtual option. Social distancing should continue.
5. Vaccination Information such as locations and accessibility will be provided to employees upon request. Vaccinations are strongly encouraged and can help to reduce the spread of COVID-19. www.vaccinefinder.org
