<u>Updates from the Office of Prevention</u> – Per Brandon Folks and Beverly Johnson, State Opioid Response Grant has been submitted on behalf of Alabama Department of Mental Health. It is

expected for the current SOR recipients to continue providing services. ADMH will also be requesting a No Cost Extension for SOR 2.0 grantees.

The National Prevention Network (NPN) conference will be held virtually in August. Looking ahead in 2023, the Office of Prevention will be calling upon providers for some assistance and some presentations at this conference. Alabama will be the host state for NPN.
