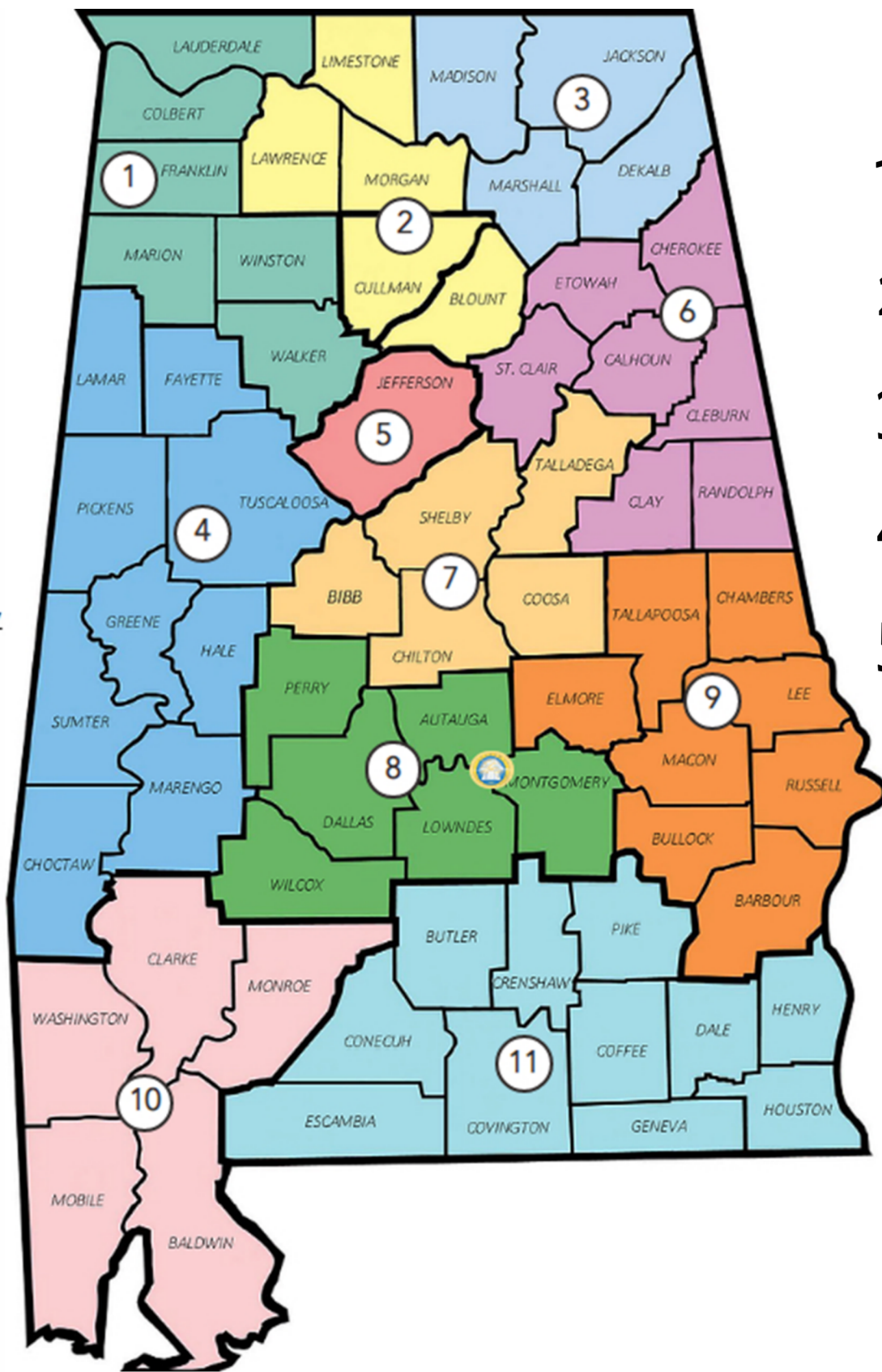
Setting Your Classroom Up for Success: Practical, Easy Tips, Tricks, and Strategies for Managing the Early Childhood Classroom
