## Qualifying Conditions

- **Prevention:** All individuals. No limitation as anyone may be affected by substances at many points in their lifetime
  - Can be targeted toward at-risk groups or geographic locations
- **Treatment:** An individual with an Opioid Use Disorder/Stimulant Use Disorder
- **Recovery Supports:** An individual actively using substances or who is in active recovery

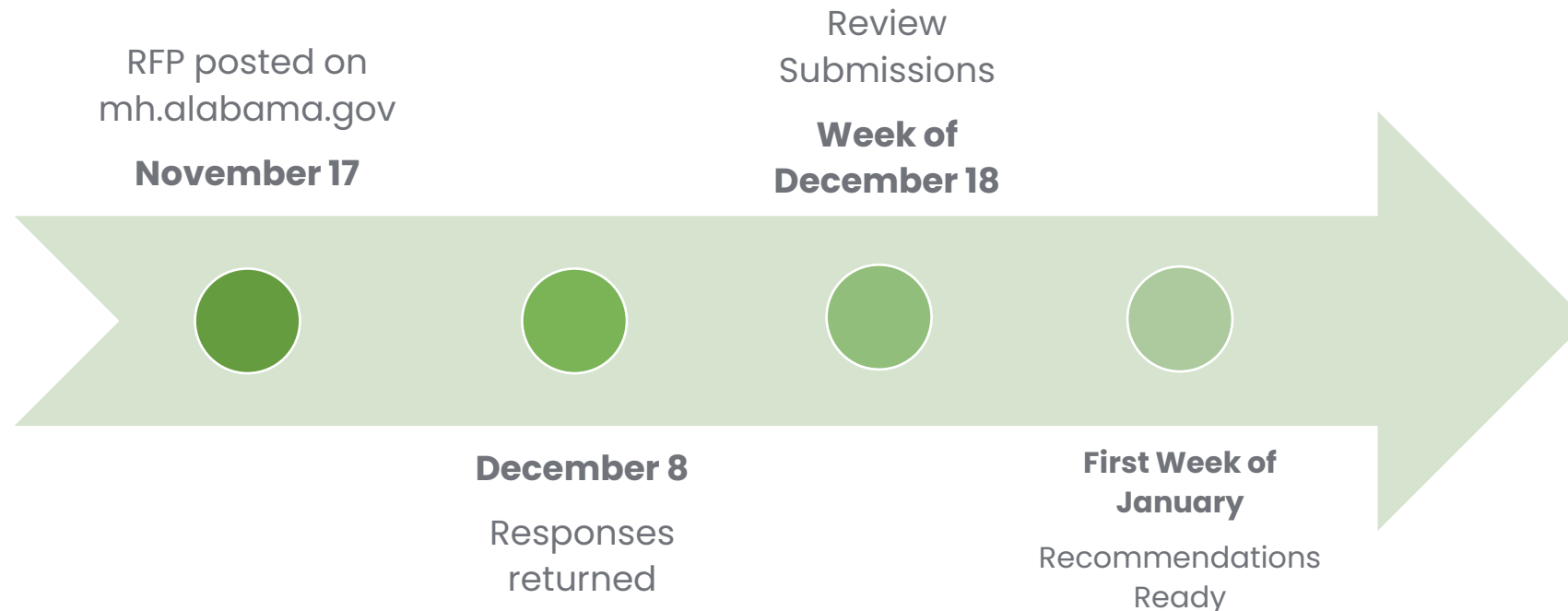
## Priority Populations

- Foster care/kinship
- Justice involved
- Veterans
- Pregnant/parenting women
- People who inject substances
- Youth/adolescent/transition age individuals
- Rural populations
- Older adults
- Individuals with a diagnosed opioid use disorder or stimulant use disorder
- Individuals at-risk of developing OUD or SUD

# Who may respond and Timeline

Public or private non-profit organizations who meet one of the following:

- Certified by ADMH to provide substance use treatment service
- Certified by ADMH to provide prevention services
- Approved by ADMH to provide recovery support services
- Can be certified or approved by ADMH to provide such services within four months of award
