

Subject: Trauma-Informed Care Training

Requirements

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- 1. Programs Affected: All CCBHC Demonstration participants.
- 2. Background and Purpose: Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs) designated by the Alabama Department of Mental Health (ADMH) as Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHCs) must provide services that are trauma informed. This bulletin describes Alabama's requirements for training related to trauma-informed care.
- 3. SAMHSA CCBHC Criteria Authority:
 - 3.1. Per Criterion 1.b.2 CCBHCs must include staff with expertise in addressing trauma and promoting the recovery of children and adolescents with serious emotional disturbance (SED) and adults with serious mental illness (SMI).
 - 3.2. Per Criterion 1.c.1 CCBHCs must have a training plan for all CCBHC employed and contracted staff who work directly with CCBHC clients or their families. The training plan must satisfy and include requirements of the state Behavioral Health Authority, and any accreditation standards required by the state. At orientation or at reasonable intervals thereafter, the CCBHC must provide training on trauma-informed care, among other topics.
 - 3.3. Per Criterion 4.c.1 CCBHCs must include training specifically focused on the application of trauma-informed approaches during crises as part of the CCBHC's training related to trauma-informed care

4. ADMH Requirements for Training on Trauma-Informed Care

- 4.1. People living with behavioral health conditions experience high rates of trauma. To prevent re-traumatization of persons served, CCBHCs must create trauma-informed environments with staff well trained in trauma-informed principles.
- 4.2. To promote a trauma-informed environment, ADMH requires all CCBHCs to submit a trauma-informed training plan that includes, at a minimum the following competencybased trainings; however, it is up to the discretion of the CCBHC to determine if a more rigorous training cycle is needed:

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- 4.3. CCBHCs will be required to submit their trauma-informed care training plan to ADMH within 90 days of certification.
- 4.4. CCBHCs are required to maintain records of trainings delivered in addition to their staff with verification of competency assessments.
