Steps to Becoming a CCBHC

1. The Certified 310 Community Mental Health Center (CMHC) will contact the Office of CCBHC.
2. The CMHC will submit a CCBHC Certification Compliance Checklist to ccbhc.dmh@mh.alabama.gov
3. The Office of CCBHC will schedule a pre-meeting with the CMHC to discuss provider capacity and readiness.
4. The CMHC will enter CCBHC Provisional Implementation Status and must:
 - a. Submit the CCBHC Certification Application
 - b. Submit a complete Community Needs Assessment (CNA)
 - c. Begin Cost Reporting work as outlined by CMS
 - i. Alabama CCHBCs must have a certified PPS rate by the Alabama Medicaid Agency to be eligible to claim the PPS-1 daily rate for CCBHC services.
 - d. Apply for Provider NPI for CCBHC
 - e. Complete the Alabama Medicaid Agency provider enrollment application for CCBHC
 - f. Complete a CCBHC Service Verification with the Office of CCBHC
5. SAMHSA Approval
 - a. The ADMH will submit a complete application packet on behalf of the interested CMHC and must receive approval from SAMHSA before a CMHC is determined eligible for Demonstration entry. All requested materials must be submitted to ADMH at least **60** days prior to desired entry.
6. Technical Assistance (ADMH required and/or agency requested)
7. The CMHC must complete the ADMH required site visit/certification process.
