Reporting Requirements

Episode data is required under the following conditions for members under the age of 21:

- Member offered HICC
- Member referred for ICC, but ICC is not offered to the member (i.e., Youth referred for service but does not meet service criteria for service; for example, LICC and HICC are not medically necessary, Primary Non-SED, out of age range, setting excludes HICC delivery, HICC would be a duplicative service, etc.)
- Member referred for IHI
