FACILITATING ATTUNED INTERACTIONS

The Facilitating Attuned Interactions (FAN) framework is a practical tool for building relationships in a wide range of settings. FAN helps professionals read cues from parents and themselves, leading to empathetic and appropriate responses in even the most difficult conversations.

BUILDING YOUR BOUNCE

Building Your Bounce is a curriculum developed by the Devereux Center for Resilient Children. This training offers a fun way for adults to recognize the importance of their own resilience and how it relates to their ability to provide quality care for children.

UNDERSTANDING TRAUMA IN YOUNG CHILDREN

Trauma causes unique effects on the lives of children ages birth to 5. This training explores a broad and inclusive view of trauma and provides practical ways that professionals can infuse trauma knowledge and understanding into their daily work.

DIAGNOSTIC CLASSIFICATION OF MENTAL HEALTH & DEVELOPMENT DISORDERS OF INFANCY & EARLY CHILDHOOD (DC:0-5)

The DC:0-5 is a developmentally based system for diagnosing mental health problems in the earliest years by identifying and describing disorders not addressed in other classification systems and by pointing the way to effective intervention approaches.
