Services

Intensive Care Coordination

Identification, coordination, and navigation of community agencies, services and supports by a single case manager.

In Home Therapy/Mental Health Support

Treatment of the child's behavioral and mental health needs to help improve the child's functioning in the home and community.

Behavior Support

Development and monitoring of a behavior support plan designed to diminish, extinguish, or improve specific behaviors including crisis management.

Therapeutic Mentoring

Coaching, and training for a child in communication, social skills, daily living skills, problem solving, and conflict resolution

Youth/Family Peer Support

Peer specialists encourage participation in service planning, improving self-management, decision making, and navigating child-serving agencies.

Psychoeducational Services

Training to help children and families understand nature of diagnosis and effective strategies to maintain meaningful engagement in the community.
